

## INVITATION

Dear colleagues, dear friends,

We are pleased to cordially invite **PhD students of analytical chemistry** (and, of course, also those undergraduate students of analytical chemistry who are interested in) to the traditional meeting, to the **15th International Students Conference 'Modern Analytical Chemistry'**. This year the conference will be held on **September 19–20, 2019**, at the Institute of Chemistry, Faculty of Science, Charles University, Prague, the Czech Republic.

The main goal of the event is to improve the presentation skills, to provide the floor for discussion and exchange of experiences, and to master the English language of the participants. Therefore, the whole **programme is carried out in the English language**. The two day program will consist of oral communication by young scientists in the different research fields of analytical chemistry.

The **presentations are solely oral**, accompanied by PowerPoint (or similar) presentation. The topic of the presentation should be focused on analytical chemistry, not on simple application of analytical techniques for solving non-analytical problems.

Similarly to the previous years, the proceedings of contributions will be published. Like in previous years, the proceedings will be index in **the database Web of Science** (Conference Proceedings Citation Index - Science). Therefore only full text contributions (not only short abstracts) will be included to the proceedings.

We have also the hope of having **the conference number of an international, impacted journal**.

The conference participants are **free of any conference fee** (with the exception of transport), and, besides the conference materials, they will be supplied with dinners, get-together party, and coffee breaks. The registration form and the manuscript of the contribution should be sent to the organizers **not later than June 23, 2019**. If the number of registered participants exceeds 60, the organizers reserve the earlier end of registration.
